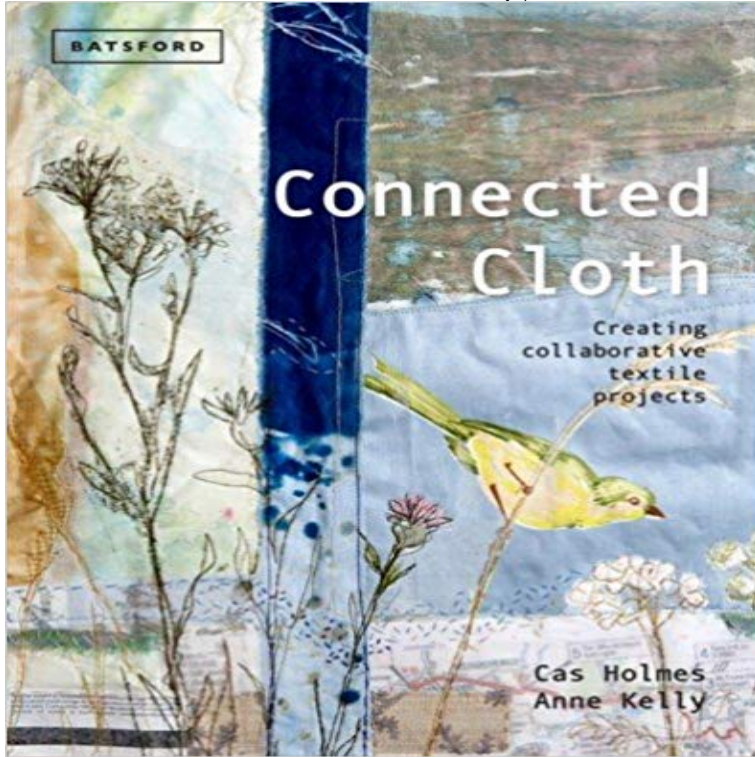


Connected Cloth: Creating Collaborative Textile Projects
