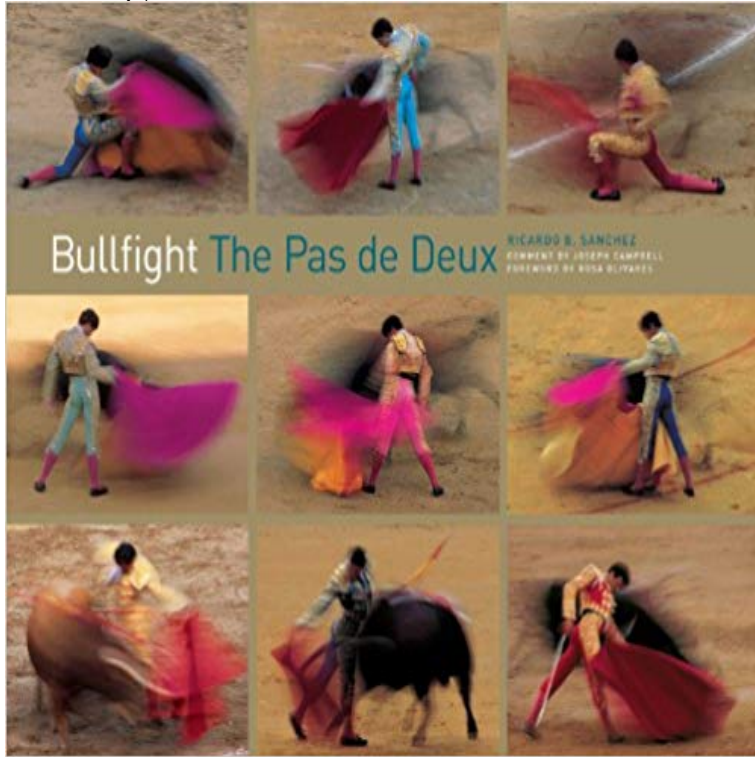


Bullfight: The Pas de Deux
