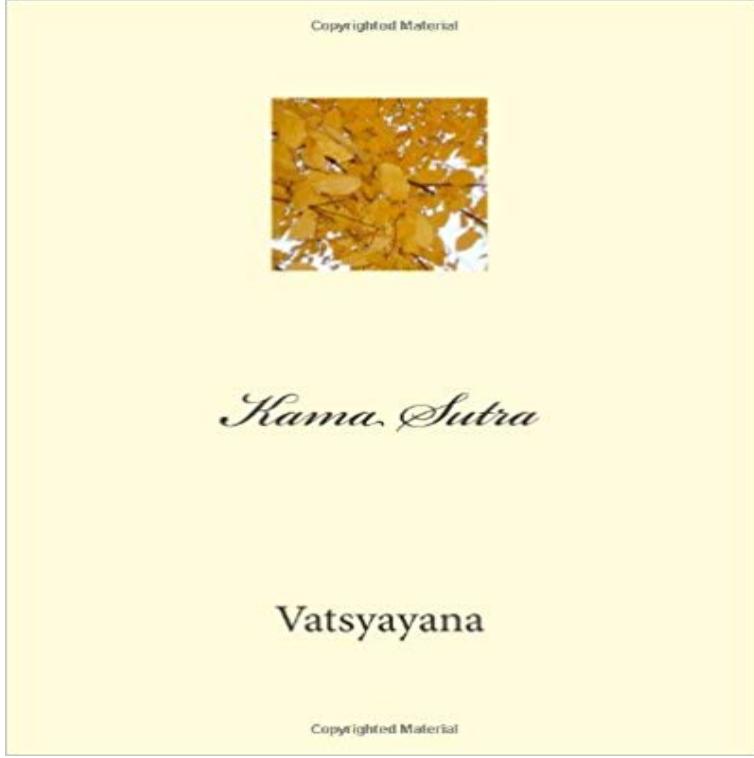


Kama Sutra: Translated from the Sanscrit
