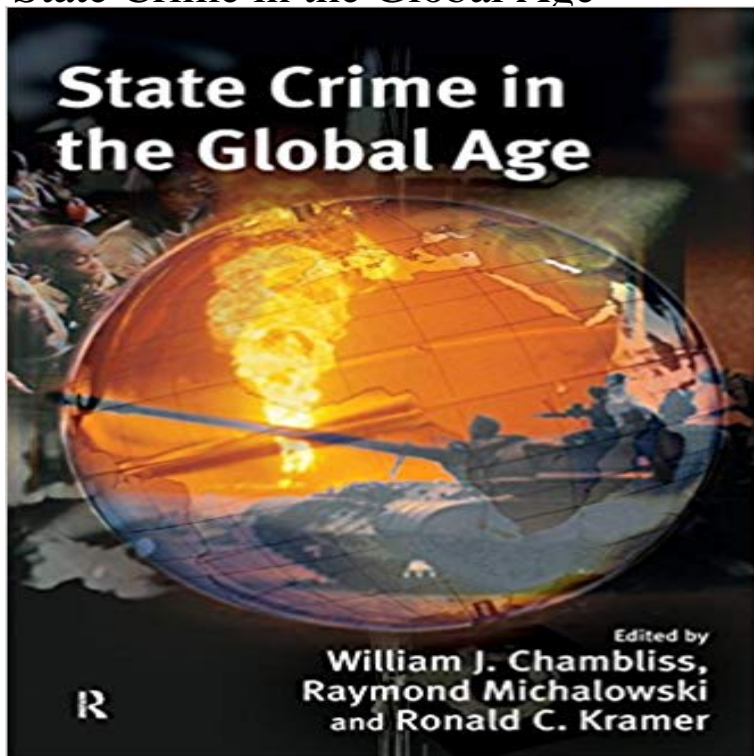


State Crime in the Global Age
