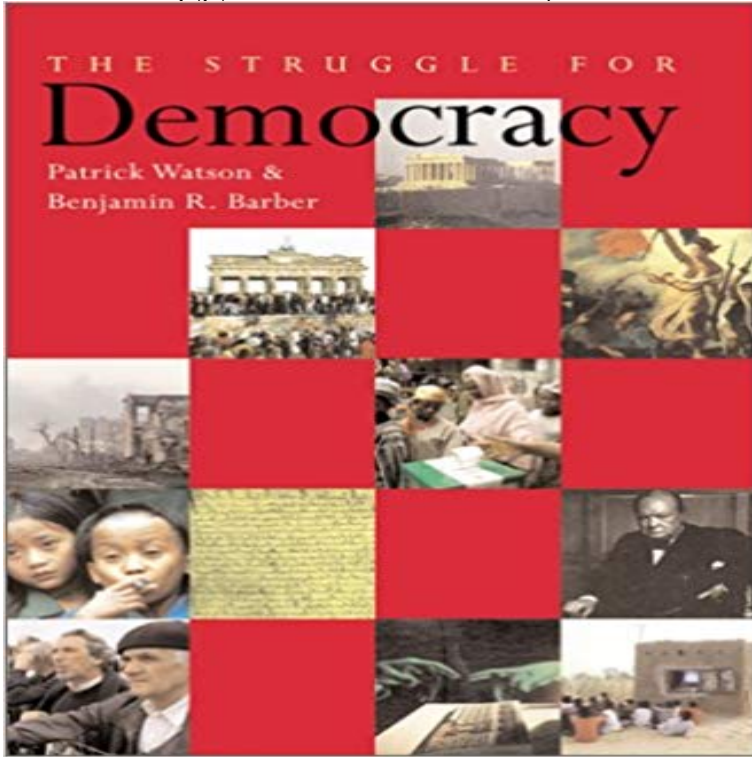


The Struggle for Democracy
