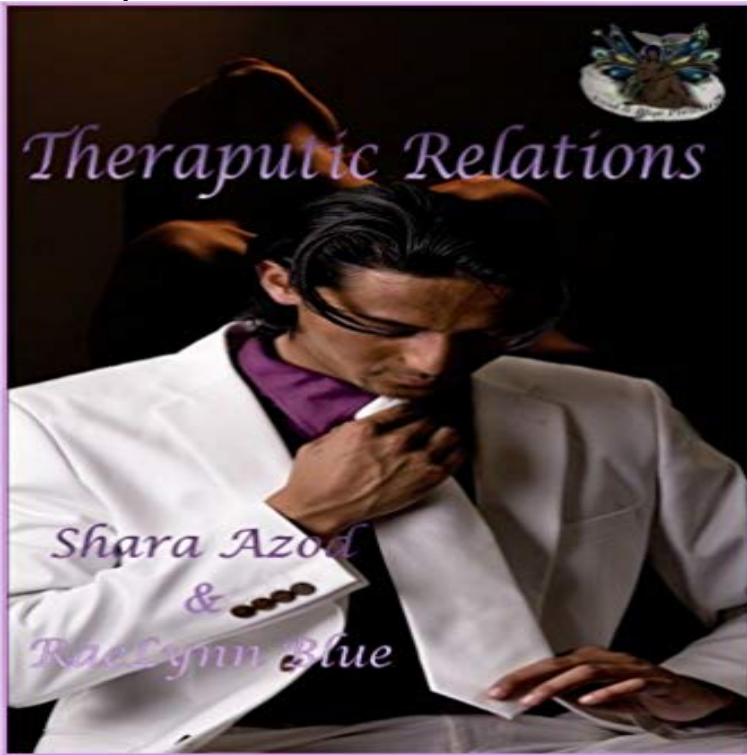


Therapeutic Relations
