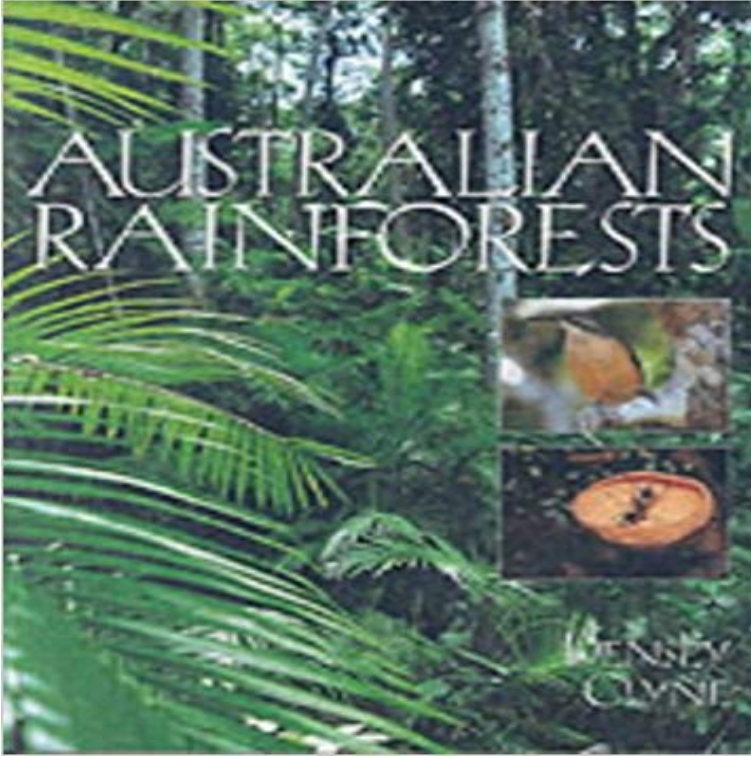


## Australian Rainforests
